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

Matthew 10:33-37 But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven...... (37) He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

Proverbs 13:24 He who spares his rod hates his son, **But he who loves him disciplines him promptly**.

Proverbs 19:18 Chasten your son while there is hope, And do not set your heart on his destruction.

Proverbs 29:17 Correct your son, and he will give you rest; Yes, he will give delight to your soul.

How do I put God deep into my son's heart?

Exodus 13:14 So it shall be, **when your son asks** you in time to come, saying, 'What is this?' that **you shall say to him**, 'By strength of hand the LORD brought us out of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

Deuteronomy 6:5-9 You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. (6) "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. (7) You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. (8) You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. (9) You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

We should not measure these inspired words by the latest accepted theories, but should measure the latest theories my these God given commands! (*Kelfer*)

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My favorite verses.....

Hebrews 10:24-25 And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, (25) **not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together**, as *is* the manner of some, but exhorting *one another*, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Ephesians 6:4 And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.




You Will Not Be Popular.....

Choosing a "Helper"


- Not good for man to live alone

1 Kings 2:1-3

Now the days of David drew near that he should die, and he charged Solomon his son, saying: (2) "I go the way of all the earth; be strong, therefore, and prove yourself a man. (3) And keep the charge of the LORD your God: to walk in His ways, to keep His statutes, His commandments, His judgments, and His testimonies, as it is written in the Law of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do and wherever you turn.

2 Peter 1:12-14

For this reason I will not be negligent to remind you always of these things, though you know and are established in the present truth. 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A note from Will, my son....

It really helped me that I wasn't pushed to do anything by my dad, whether sports, music, school, etc. The only obligation was serving the Lord. And because that was the only thing, I knew that was a priority and nothing else in this world mattered.

Walks are also good, my dad and I walked about twice a week during my high school years. I guess walks are a good way for a father to show his son he can also be his good friend. I was always honest with my dad because I knew he would not react violently to what I was telling him. Because I knew he would be understanding, and would relate to some of my problems, I told him a lot of things I otherwise would not have told him. We are more like great friends rather than father and son.
