Events in the text

God's judgment on mankind (6:5-7, 11-12; see Psalm 14)

> Q: How did God determine that mankind was wicked?

The Flood

- Q: Where did the water originate? (7:11-12; also see Prov. 8:22-29)
- Q: How did Noah prevent the animals from eating one another? (see Gen. 1:30; 9:3-4)
- > Q: What was the purpose of the flood?

The new beginning (8:11, 17-19; 9:1-7)

Changes to the world after the Flood

Covenant between God and "all flesh" (9:8-17)

Sons of God / daughters of man (6:1-2)
