




God Prescribes the Preparation

- •For the priests
 - ·Bringing a bull for purification
 - •Bringing a ram for burnt offering
- •For the people
 - Bringing goats
 - •One for a sacrifice
 - •One for a "Scapegoat"



Purification of Blood

- Offered bull for him and his family
 - Censors lit from altar of burnt offering
 - •Sweet incense for the fire before the Lord
 - •Sprinkled blood from priestly offering on mercy seat seven times
- •Cloud would cover the mercy seat lest Aaron die
- •Offered "goat to the Lord" for the people (of God's choosing)
 - •Sprinkled blood for congregations offering on mercy seat and east of mercy seat



Purification through Removal - The Scapegoat

- ·Aaron would confess every sin
 - •Transferring the sins by laying hands on the head of the goat
 - •A "suitable" man would lead the goat away
 - ·Left in a region "cut off" to the camp

"And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all." Isaiah 53:6



A Permanent Statue - Tishri 10

- People refrained from working
- People humbled themselves
- •God made atonement for all people

And this shall be a statute for ever unto you: that in the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, ye shall afflict your souls, and do no work at all, whether it be one of your own country, or a stranger that sojourneth among you: For on that day shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the LORD.

And this shall be an everlasting statute unto you, to make an atonement for the children of Israel for all their sins once a year. And he did as the LORD commanded Moses. 16:34
