Lesson 2: Jacob's Flight to Padan Aram

Reading: Genesis 27:1-28:22

In the latter part of Chapter 25, the family of Isaac begins with the twin births of Jacob and Esau. Jacob comes into the world clinging to the heel of Esau with a prophecy that the "older shall serve the younger". Jacob and Esau are opposites with Jacob dwelling in tents and Esau hunting game. Esau has no regard for his birthright (double portion) and sells it to Jacob for a bowl of red stew; hence, Esau retains the name Edom ("red"). In Chapter 26, there is a famine in the land, and Isaac lives in Gerar. He repeats Abraham's practice of telling Abimelech, king of Gerar, that his wife is his sister. When Abimelech learns the truth, he confronts Isaac and orders his people to leave Isaac and Rebekah alone. God causes Isaac to prosper in Gerar, doubling his crops and accumulating flocks and herds. As a result, the Philistines envy Isaac, fill up the wells which Abraham had previously dug, and send Isaac away. Isaac lives in the valley of Gerar, attempts to reopen the wells his father had dug only to be resisted, and eventually goes to Beersheba. Abimelech approaches Isaac seeking a covenant between them, recognizing that God is with Isaac. The chapter ends with Esau taking two Hittite women to be his wives.
